Aviv/Crescent Moon Appointed Times Calendar.

Jerusalem Time (Ezekiel 43:7)

<p>ALL DATES WILL OCCUR AS POSTED OR ONE DAY LATER DEPENDING ON WHEN THE 1st, 7th, 9th, and 12th MOONS ARE SIGHTED FROM ISRAEL. The 1st Moon of the calendar, the Aviv Moon, is the first Moon sighted in Israel after significant amounts of Barley have been sighted throughout the Land by two or more validated witnesses. An "Adar Bet" is a year that a 13th moon takes place before the Pesach moon arrives. <i>Light blue background provided the most likely projected Appointed Times dates</i> Golden provides the dates that the Moedim actually occurred on.</p>

The Day of Adonai/Day of Vengeance Yesh'yahu (Isaiah) 61:2,3. {Public Gathering}: No kind of work, no buying or selling; Nehem'yahu 10:31, No food preparation allowed. <i>[Observing the Day of the Eternal One's Vengeance upon the nations, and Day of Final Atonement for His People, of those Who Repented Over the 10 Days of Awe; Yesh'yahu (Isaiah) 61:2,3. The Writing of their Names in, and the Final Closing of, the Book of Life prior to the Millennial Kingdom. The soonest and latest that the Appointed Times can occur based on past observation and under current "pre" Yesh'yahu (Isaiah) 24:18b-20 conditions. The soonest Pesach can currently occur approx: Mar. 26. The latest Pesach can currently occur approx: Apr. 27. The soonest Shavuot can currently occur (Adjusted for Aviv style Omer count) approx: M-y 18 (M-y 14 by Hillel). The latest Shavuot can currently occur (Adjusted for Aviv style Omer count) approx: Jun. 20 (Jun. 13 by Hillel).

*When the 1st of Unleavened Bread falls on S-day (S-tuesday night to S-day day), the First Fruits are waived the same day; Yehoshua (Joshua) 5:10,11 (See Time Line 13, On Counting the Omer).
