## *On Pesach and the 7 days of Unleavened Bread As Ordained in Shemot (Exodus) 12*

<p><b>14<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> <b>Pesach</b> <i>Unleavened Bread Eaten with Lamb.</i></p> <p><i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pesach.</li> <li>2. Yeast is removed from house.</li> <li>3. First day of eight where haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) is eaten.</li> <li>4. Lamb killed at setting of sun at dusk, and roasted and consumed with HaMatzot with family in privacy of the home.</li> <li>5. <b><i>It is night of (beginning of) the 14<sup>th</sup> and Israelites are forbidden to leave homes until morning.</i></b></li> <li>6. All first born killed that night who did not have blood on doorposts.</li> <li>7. Lamb consumed before dawn and all leftover lamb burned in morning.</li> <li>8. Flocks, herds and people gathered in preparation to flee Egypt.</li> <li>9. Israelites plunder Egyptians.</li> <li>10. Israel is led first in the daylight with pillar of cloud, then led that following night with a pillar of fire.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <p><b>15<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 1) of Feast of Unleavened Bread</p> <p><i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 1<sup>st</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) and Day of Public Assembly;</li> <li>2. <b><i>Israel flees the borders of Egypt this day following Pesach.</i></b></li> <li>3. <b><i>It is the night of (beginning of) the 15<sup>th</sup>.</i></b></li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6,7;</li> <li>2. <b><i>Shemot (Exodus) 12:17; B'midbar (Numbers) 33:3</i></b></li> <li>3. <b><i>D'varim (Deuteronomy) 16:1</i></b></li> </ol>	<p>DAY 2</p>
<p><b>16<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 2) <i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<p>2<sup>nd</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 3</p>
<p><b>17<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 3) <i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<p>3<sup>rd</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 4</p>
<p><b>18<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 4) <i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<p>4<sup>th</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 5</p>
<p><b>19<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 5) <i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<p>5<sup>th</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 6</p>
<p><b>20<sup>th</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 6) <i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<p>6<sup>th</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 7</p>
<p><b>21<sup>st</sup> of Aviv</b> (Day 7) of Feast of Unleavened Bread</p> <p><i>No Yeast Eaten</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 7<sup>th</sup> day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) and Day of Public Assembly</li> <li>2. 8<sup>th</sup> day out of eight where haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) has been eaten.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6,8;</li> <li>2. Shemot (Exodus) 12:18;</li> </ol>	<p>DAY 8</p>
